

# Independent Medical Panel

The Injuries Resolution Board is Ireland's independent state body which resolves claims for personal injuries following motor, workplace and public place accidents. Since April 2023, the Board also resolves personal injury claims from Gardai who have been maliciously injured. The Board was established in 2004 to support the fair, prompt, and transparent resolution of personal injury claims without the need for unnecessary litigation.

The Injuries Resolution Board currently has a panel of medical consultants and specialists in place that provide independent medical reports to the Board as required.

Independent medical assessment of claimants within the Injuries Resolution Board process is an essential step in the delivery of our service and therefore continuity of supply is paramount.

To refresh and expand our medical panel across all regions in the Republic of Ireland, the Injuries Resolution Board wishes to invite suitably qualified medical practitioners to express their interest in inclusion on this panel.

Our Independent Panel members may be requested to assess claimants and produce a medical reports following examination of the injured persons claim, and give a description and opinion on the injury, the related care given, recovery and any ongoing symptoms.

- Placement on the Panel does not infer any employment by the Injuries Resolution Board but is an agreement by the provider to provide services by way of service level agreement for an agreed rate.
- Placement on the Injuries Resolution Board Independent Medical Panel is not a guarantee of referrals.
- The medical panel remains open for applications throughout the year.
